



Privacy Statement (Fear of Night-time Hypoglycaemia)

The purpose of this statement is to advise those completing the 'Fear on Night-time Hypoglycaemia' survey, which has been developed and distributed by the [DANII Foundation](#), why personal details are being collected and how the information will be used.

Collecting Personal Information

The 'Fear of Night-time Hypoglycaemia' survey has been prepared by the DANII Foundation to investigate the affects of hypoglycaemia on people with type 1 diabetes and their families.

The prime purpose of the DANII Foundation is to raise funds, lobby industry and government to introduce latest technologies, at an affordable price, that assist in the management of type 1 diabetes. This survey aims to establish quantitative figures to demonstrate how the fear of nighttime hypoglycemia affects people with type 1 diabetes and their families. These quantitative figures will be used in lobbying efforts.

The survey asks for personal details such as full name, date of birth street address, email address and phone number. These details are voluntary and are not required to be completed in order for respondents to complete the survey. The details are only used when processing survey results to verify responses are collected by patients and their families rather than automated systems.

Distribution of Collected Personal Information

The personal information provided by those completing the survey will not be distributed to outside parties. Personal information may be used by the DANII Foundation for future communications.

The DANII Foundation will use the birth date and date of diagnosis entered to further define the information collected by this survey in to age groups and duration of disease; however this information will not be distributed in conjunction with personal information.

Storage and Transportation of Collected Personal Information

Responses to this survey are stored securely by the DANII Foundation and can only be accessed by authorised personnel. All survey responses are submitted using a secure SSL connection.

Survey responses will be held indefinitely. Data collected may be published in various forms to support the Foundation's mission.
